Methods of Obtaining Application Forms (No quota for application forms)

1. Download from the kindergarten website
2. Obtain in person from the kindergarten

Period for Distribution of Application Forms

1. Date: Application forms are distributed throughout the year
(children may apply upon reaching the age of 1)
2. Time: Monday to Friday (8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.)
Saturday (8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.)

Submission of Application Forms (No quota for collection of admission application forms)

1. Deadline: 31 August 2026 (Monday)
2. Time: Monday to Friday (8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.)
Saturday (8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.)
3. Submission method: Submit the application form online / in person / by post to the kindergarten
【together with the required documents (including identity documents)】
4. Application fee: HK\$40 (to be collected upon submission of the application form). The application fee is non-refundable regardless of whether the application is successful.

Application for the “Registration Certificate for Kindergarten Admission” for the 2027/28 School Year

1. The Education Bureau will implement the Free Quality Kindergarten Education policy in the 2027/28 school year. Under the new scheme, the Education Bureau will use the “Registration Certificate for Kindergarten Admission” as the registration document for K1 in the 2027/28 school year.
2. Parents are required to apply to the Education Bureau for an electronic “Registration Certificate” for their children between September and November 2026. Applications for the “2027/28 Registration Certificate” will begin in September this year. The Education Bureau will announce the application details in due course and upload the relevant information to its website (https://www.edb.gov.hk/tc/edu-system/preprimary-kindergarten/kindergarten-k1-admission-arrangements/AppForm_2728.html).

Admission Criteria

1. Interview performance
2. Applicants whose siblings are currently studying in this kindergarten will be given priority consideration
3. Priority will be given to families requiring whole-day services (such as dual-income families), as well as families requiring whole-day class services due to special circumstances
(such as families who need to care for persons with disabilities at home).

(Please note that due to limited school places, not all applicants who meet the priority consideration criteria will be admitted.)

Support for Admission of Non-Chinese Speaking Children

1. The school will upload the application form and other relevant information to the school website for parents to browse and download, with both Chinese and English versions available. To facilitate access to relevant information for parents of non-Chinese speaking children, the school has placed an icon, simple English prompts or an English webpage link in a prominent position on the homepage of the school website, so that parents of non-Chinese speaking children can immediately obtain the English version of the information when browsing the homepage. The school also provides, in a prominent position on the school website, the English webpage link for the Education Bureau's Kindergarten Nursery Class (K1) Admission Arrangements (https://www.edb.gov.hk/k1-admission_e) and the English webpage link to the page showing the school's information in the Profile of Kindergartens and Kindergarten-cum-Child Care Centres, so as to facilitate parents' access to relevant information. The school website states the school's support measures for non-Chinese speaking children and provides an enquiry telephone number and email address for parents of non-Chinese speaking children.
2. The school provides equal opportunities for admission to all children, regardless of race, gender or ability, including properly handling the applications of non-Chinese speaking children in view of the fact that their cultural customs may not be exactly the same as those of the local community. If school places are available, the school will continue to admit children from different backgrounds and with different needs. To facilitate enquiries from parents of non-Chinese speaking children about the school-based admission mechanism, parents may contact the school by telephone at 23333279 or by email at ywyic@pokoi.org.hk. At the same time, the school ensures that staff participating in the admission process clearly understand and implement the arrangements for handling applications from non-Chinese speaking children and their parents, such as providing an English version of the application form and school admission guidelines for parents of non-Chinese speaking children.
3. When interviewing non-Chinese speaking children, the school will arrange interpretation and/or translation services for applicants as needed. The school also accepts parents and children being accompanied by relatives or friends who understand Chinese to assist with communication during the interview. The kindergarten states the above interview arrangements on the school website so that parents of non-Chinese speaking children are aware that the school can provide relevant assistance. At the same time, the kindergarten has established effective communication channels and will provide assistance to non-Chinese speaking children and parents as far as possible.

Interview Arrangements

1. The kindergarten will arrange interviews for all children applying for admission to the Nursery Class
2. Interviews will be conducted on 14 November 2026. The kindergarten will notify parents separately in writing
3. Interviews will be conducted in groups
4. Parents must accompany their children to attend the interview

Announcement of Admission Results

The kindergarten will notify parents of the Nursery Class admission results by post on or before 11 December 2026.

Registration Arrangements

1. Admitted students: Parents must complete the registration procedures at the kindergarten at the specified time between 7 and 9 January 2027 (“Centralised Registration Dates”), allowing the school to scan the QR code on the electronic “Registration Certificate”, and pay the registration fee.
2. Students on the waiting list: If school places become available before September 2027, the kindergarten will contact parents. If no notification is received during the above period, it means that no school place can be arranged for this school year. If parents still wish their child to remain on the waiting list, please notify the school in writing for arrangement.
3. The registration fee for the 2027/28 school year is HK\$1,570. If the child is admitted to the school, the registration fee will be deducted from the tuition fee for the first month of the first term of the 2027/28 school year.

However, if parents decide to transfer their child to another school after registration, please notify the kindergarten in writing. The kindergarten will return the relevant Registration Certificate, but the registration fee will not be refunded. After the Registration Certificate has been collected, the kindergarten will no longer reserve the school place for the child.
